Dn. Perry Hamalis — Rev. Dr. Perry Hamalis is the Cecelia Schneller Mueller Professor of Religion at North Central College, where he teaches courses in Religious and Philosophical Ethics. He was awarded a Fulbright Senior Research Fellowship and was appointed as a Visiting Professor of Theology at Yonsei University in Seoul, South Korea. It was during this time that he was ordained a deacon of the Ecumenical Patriarchate by His Eminence Metropolitan Ambrosios of Korea. Deacon Perry has lectured across the U.S., in Greece, Switzerland, Germany, Australia, and Korea on topics pertaining to Eastern Orthodoxy, Death, Bioethics, and Social Ethics, and he has over 30 academic publications.
